



Submission Guidelines



Each best practice must be submitted in the following format (maximum two A4 pages per entry + annexures as required):

- 1. Title of the Best Practice
- 2. Institution Name & Address
- 3. Submitted by Name, Designation, Email, Mobile
- 4. Head of Institution Name, Design, Email, Mobile
- 5. Thematic Area
- 6. Context / Need for the Practice (100-150 words)
- 7. Description of the Practice (250–300 words) Covering Objectives, Key actions taken, Stakeholders involved, Timelines
- 8. Evidence of Impact (100–150 words) Covering Quantitative or qualitative outcomes Testimonials and data if available
- 9. Potential for Replication (50–100 words)
- 10. Photos / Supporting Links / References as annexures (optional)
